Airport Authority Launches Airport Construction E-Alerts

SAN DIEGO – February 24, 2010 – The San Diego County Regional Airport Authority recently launched an airport construction alert system to keep travelers informed about construction around Terminal 2 related to The Green Build, the largest project in the airport's history.

E-alerts will provide timely updates about construction activity that could potentially impact travel time to/from the airport.

The Green Build will bring a number of long-awaited upgrades for passengers traveling in and out of San Diego International Airport. All travelers – whether visiting San Diego County on vacation, traveling on business or headed out of town on holiday – will reap the benefits of these improvements. Travelers can expect to take advantage of the finished facilities in 2013.

Project highlights include:

- 10 new gates at Terminal 2
- A dual-level roadway at Terminal 2 to separate arriving and departing passengers
- New, expanded dining and shopping options
- More comfortable waiting areas at the gates
- Increased number of security lanes

The San Diego County Regional Airport Authority was established by state law in 2003 to operate San Diego International Airport and to address the region's long-term air transportation needs. San Diego International Airport generates some \$10 billion in annual economic impact for the region.
